They got up and <u>returned at once to Jerusalem</u>. There they found the Eleven and those with them, assembled together 34 and saying, "It is true! The Lord has risen and has appeared to Simon." 35 Then <u>the two told what had happened on the way</u>, and how Jesus was recognized by them when he broke the bread.
