ROMANS 3:23

All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God

The problem is that no one is able to be in a right relationship with God alone.

Romans 3:10
There is no one righteous, not even one.

ROMANS 6:23

the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

The result of sin is death, eternal separation from God. But Through Jesus, we are offered eternal life with God.

ROMANS 5:8

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Christ loved us so much, that he died for our sins.

John 3:16-17

ROMANS 10:9-10

If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.
