Jesus was a LISTENER. - Luke 18:35-43; John 5:1-9

1. PAY \_\_\_\_\_

As Jesus approached Jericho, <u>a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging</u>. 36 When he heard the crowd going by, he asked what was happening. 37 They told him, "Jesus of Nazareth is passing by."

He called out, *"Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"* Luke 18:38

Those who led the way rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" Luke 18:39

#### 3. LISTEN TO \_\_\_\_\_\_ AND \_\_\_\_\_

Some time later, Jesus went up to Jerusalem for a feast of the Jews. 2 Now there is in Jerusalem near the Sheep Gate a pool, which in Aramaic is called Bethesda and which is surrounded by five covered colonnades. 3 Here a great number of disabled people used to lie - the blind, the lame, the paralyzed. John 5:1-3

One who was there had been an invalid for thirty-eight years. 6 When Jesus saw him lying there and learned that he had been in this condition for a long time, he asked him, "Do you want to get well?" John 5:4-6

"Sir," the invalid replied, "I have no one to help me into the pool when the water is stirred. While I am trying to get in, someone else goes down ahead of me." John 5:7

Then Jesus said to him, "Get up! Pick up your mat and walk." 9 At once the man was cured: he picked up his mat and walked. John 5:8
