MEET JEREMIAH Jeremiah 1 Kevin T. Hardy January 9, 2022

These are the words of **Jeremiah son of Hilkiah**, one of the priests from the town of Anathoth in the land of Benjamin. 2 The Lord first gave messages to Jeremiah during the thirteenth year of the reign of Josiah son of Amon, king of Judah. 3 **The Lord's messages** continued throughout the reign of King Jehoiakim, Josiah's son, until the eleventh year of the reign of King Zedekiah, another of Josiah's sons. In August of that eleventh year **the people of Jerusalem were taken away as captives**. (Je 1:1–3) NLT

The Lord gave me this message:

"<u>I knew you</u> before <u>I formed you</u> in your mother's womb. Before you were born <u>I set you apart</u> and <u>appointed you as my prophet</u> to the nations." (Je 1:4–5)

It was **he who gave some** to be **apostles**, some to **be prophets**, some to **be evangelists**, and some to be **pastors and teachers**, 12 to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up. (Eph. 4:11)

Brothers, **think of what you were when you were called**. Not many of you were wise by human standards; not many were influential; not many were of noble birth. 27 But **God chose the foolish things** of the world to shame the wise; **God chose the weak things** of the world to shame the strong. 28 <u>He</u> **chose the lowly things** of this world and the **despised things** — and the things that are not — **to nullify the things that are**, (1 Cor. 1:26-28)

Then the Lord said to me, <u>"Look, Jeremiah! What do you see?"</u> And I replied, "I see a branch from an <u>almond tree</u>." 12 And the Lord said, <u>"That's right, and it means that I am watching</u>, and <u>I will certainly carry out</u> <u>all my plans."</u> (Je 1:11–12)

Then the Lord spoke to me again and asked, <u>"What do you see now?"</u> And I replied, <u>"I see a pot of boiling water, spilling from the north."</u> 14 "Yes," the Lord said, "for terror from the north will boil out on the people of this land. 15 Listen! I am calling the armies of the kingdoms of the north to come to Jerusalem. I, the Lord, have spoken! (Je 1:13– 15)

17 "Get up and prepare for action.

Go out and tell them everything I tell you to say. Do not be afraid of them, or I will make you look foolish in front of them. 18 For see, today <u>I have made you strong</u> <u>like a fortified city</u> that cannot be captured, <u>like an iron pillar or a bronze wall.</u> You will stand against the whole land the kings, officials, priests, and people of Judah. 19 They will fight you, but they will fail. For I am with you, and I will take care of you. (Je 1:17–19)

Like Jeremiah, <u>you must strong in the Lord and in his mighty power</u>" (Ephesians 6:10). You must get ready for combat, putting on <u>"the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the</u> <u>devil's schemes</u>" (v. 11). You must gird up your loins, standing firm with "the belt of truth buckled around your waist" (v. 14). Is anything in this world stronger than a believer who stands firm in the promises of God?
